

(1) Steps toward government subsidized HIV treatment (ART hereafter)

Step 1	Contact a local HIV support organization. Make consultation and identify needs.
Step 2	A local organization contacts Spiritia Foundation
Step 3	Spiritia Foundation identifies a hospital which meets the needs of a client.
Step 4	Spiritia Foundation refers PLWH to a doctor in a hospital or private clinic for necessary service and support.
Step 5	Then following the process until the client got the treatment without any problem facing in the process

(2) Options to get ART if you do not meet condition for government subsidy

There is no drug available to buy legally manage by government. All the drugs are free. So no mechanism to buy if not suit the available choices.
